MORENO VALLEY, Calif., [Month Day, Year] — Acts of Kindness Foundation, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, today announced its public launch as a Board-governed charitable organization serving Riverside County and the broader Inland Empire, with nine Foundation-administered program pillars designed to turn community generosity into accountable, partner-delivered assistance.

The Foundation is recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as a tax-exempt public charity under Section 501(c)(3) (EIN 41-5261893). Federal exemption became effective March 11, 2026. Primary operations focus on Moreno Valley, Riverside, Perris, and surrounding Inland Empire communities, with select partner-supported initiatives where verified need and compliant use of funds allow broader reach.

"Acts of Kindness Foundation exists to meet real hardship with dignity, transparency, and disciplined stewardship," said Giovanni Venegas, President and Director of Acts of Kindness Foundation. "We built a multi-program charitable platform so donors, grantmakers, and community partners can support food security, housing stability, disaster response, education access, health pathways, and related basic-needs work through verified partners — not vague promises."

How assistance is delivered: All funds are administered by Acts of Kindness Foundation with full discretion over allocation. Assistance is delivered exclusively through verified partners or direct vendor payments — never as unrestricted cash to individuals. Assistance is subject to program capacity and verified need.
