**Acts of Kindness Foundation, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, today announced its public launch as a Board-governed charitable organization serving Riverside County and the broader Inland Empire, with nine Foundation-administered program pillars designed to turn community generosity into accountable, partner-delivered assistance.**

The Foundation is recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as a tax-exempt public charity under Section 501(c)(3) (EIN 41-5261893). Federal exemption became effective March 11, 2026. Primary operations focus on Moreno Valley, Riverside, Perris, and surrounding Inland Empire communities, with select partner-supported initiatives where verified need and compliant use of funds allow broader reach.

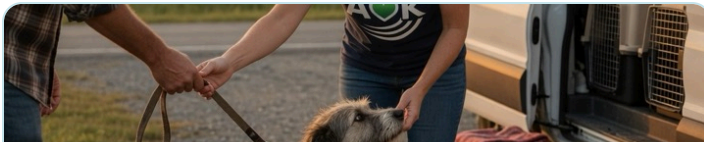

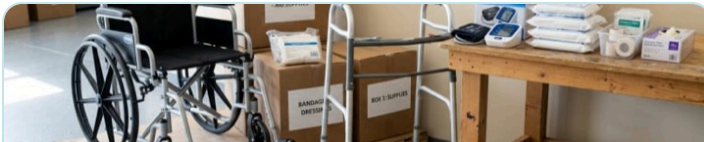

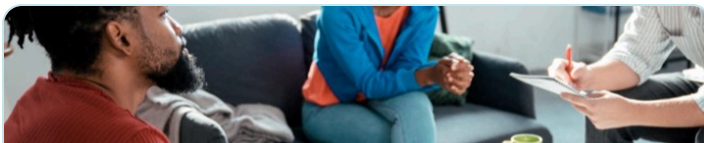
